

(A) Market Place

The originally narrow market place received its present appearance mostly in the period after the Second World War. Several buildings have been preserved from the 16th century, including the Vogtshaus (today: German Butchers Museum) and the neighbouring town clerk's office.



(B) Tithe Barn

The building by the former city wall was built in the 16th century and was used for the transfer and storage of the levies. At the beginning of the 19th century, it was home to the laboratory of the pharmacist Bonz, whose company later developed the pure narcosether.



The tower at the foot of the Town Church is one of the surviving remains of the 16th century city fortifications. It was built in the 14th century and received its name due to the color of its roof tiles which you can still see today! In the 19th century it served as a prison.



D) Town Church

The St. Dionysius Protestant Church has become the symbol of the city and dates back to the 13th/14th century. During the bombing in 1943, the church was largely destroyed and rebuilt in 1949/50. The 16th century choir and the organ are definately worth seeing.



(E) Post Square

A post office and a hotel were built here in the 19th century. The post square developed as an important hub of travel and goods and connected important roads in the region. Since 1829, the beer brewery Dinkela(c)ker (today: Schönbuch Braumanufaktur) is located here.



F) Flugfeld

From 1925 to 1938, the Flugfeld (airfield) site was home to the first state airport in Württemberg. The entrance buildings and some aircraft halls have been preserved and are now integrated into the MOTORWORLD. Since 2006, a new city quarter has been built here.

(5) German Peasant War Museum

On 12 May 1525, insurgent peasants and the Swabian League troops fought an unequal battle at the gates of Böblingen.

With numerous exhibits, the museum shows the triggers and stations of the largest mass movement in German history.





(6) Municipal Gallery

The Municipal Gallery in the glass building of the medieval tithe barn focuses on paintings, graphics and sculptures of Classical

Modernism. Versatile avantgarde art movements from the first half of the 20th century are represented here.





The 16th century Vogtshaus is home to the first and only museum in Germany that presents the history of the traditional butcher's trade.

Thematically appropriate but also unusual exhibitions round off the program.





(8) Schönbuch Beer Brewery

Experience the art of brewing up close - on a tour through the brewing manufactory. Here you will get to know the individual stages of beer production. The

(9) Outdoor Swimming Pool

The Böblinger outdoor pool is one of the most beautiful in the region. The sports pool with eight 50-metre lanes, the adventure pool with spuds, massage jets and flow channel as well as whirlpool sands and slides ensure fun and relaxation.



(10) Indoor Swimming Pool

The Böblinger indoor pool offers eight 25-metre lanes, a whirlpool, baby area and an outdoor terrace.

(11) Thermal Spa Böblingen
